
#### **Eye Care Kit for Road Safety**

"Eye Can Drive Safely" is an Eye Care Kit launched by the Traffic Police (TP) in collaboration with the Singapore Optometric Association and this Kit will be deployed during road safety engagements.

The Eye Care Kit comprises four simple tests to check one's peripheral vision, ability to distinguish details and colour contrasts. It is usable by all road users including pedestrians and users of active mobility devices and is not limited to motorists.

Do note that these eye tests are not scientific replicates of actual eye tests done at an optometrist. The results are only meant to give the individual a rough gauge of his/her visual functionality. If an individual encounters difficulty with one or more of the tests, it could be an indication of potential vision problems, and TP would encourage the individual to visit an optometrist for a proper eye check-up.

Having good vision is important for road users to use the roads safely, and TP would like to remind all road users, regardless of their age, not to take their vision for granted.

Helps **all** road users to be more aware of their surroundings and not to take safety for granted




# 3 elements of visual functionality:

Do all the boxes look square and same size?


Are there any holes or dark areas?
